Intermediate Camp (Strings only)

Time: 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (9 a.m. – 2 p.m 8/12)

Fee: \$110 (instruction, music use, & T-shirt) OR \$125 after July 14

Requirements note for parents and teachers:

This program is for students in 8th grade and under (typically entering 6th-8th grade) who are playing **at least** at the level of the end of Book 2 of a school orchestra book. They should read music, identify and play common flats and sharps, use extended hand positions, know notes on all four strings, & have a good grasp of rhythm and intonation and ability to play independently. **Please sign up for Intermediate only if you solidly meet the requirements.**

Advanced Camp (Strings and winds, brass, percussion)

Time: 12:45 p.m. – 3:45 p.m. (9:00 a.m.– 2 pm 8/12)

Fee: \$110 (instruction, music use, & T-shirt) \$125 after July 14

Requirements note for parents and teachers:

This program is for students in 11th grade and under, (typically entering 8th - 10th grade) who are able to read music, have some previous ensemble experience, can play **independently** on their instruments. A good grasp of rhythm and intonation is crucial. In addition to intermediate requirements, **Advanced Strings:** should be comfortable shifting in 1st–4th positions. (Cellists 1st-5th position) **Winds, brass:** students should have a 2-octave range, & experience with sharps. **Please sign up for Advanced only if you solidly meet the requirements.**

NOTES: Dal Segno (pronounced “Dahl SAYN-yo) is a day camp for **musicians in 11th grade & younger**, run by Northern Valley Youth Orchestras. Students learn to work cooperatively with others at their playing level through chamber ensemble coaching and rehearsals that focus on improving rehearsal techniques, discovering new musical concepts, and developing a team approach to ensemble playing. It’s challenging, but a lot of fun! Camp days also include time for social activities and teamwork skill building. We say Dal Segno is “serious fun.”

Please read:

The five-day camp sessions will end with a public performance/share day on **Friday, August 12th around noon** at the Myra Museum Gazebo. Both sessions will all attend camp in the morning and perform together. Students may share some music earlier in the week. There may also be a Saturday performance at the farmers market if enough campers are able to attend.

Due to the nature of small group ensemble playing, students **must attend camp every day** and must **be present at the concert**. If your child will have **any** conflicts with camp days, please call Naomi Welsh (701-213-0310) before registering to find out if it will be possible to participate. Students also will need to completely fill out information about their present playing levels and materials to be placed appropriately into chamber ensembles.

NOTE: Dal Segno is a day camp only, with no supervision before or after registered sessions.
