Requirements note for parents and teachers:

This program is for students in 8th grade and under (typically entering 6th-8th grade) who are playing at least at the level of the end of Book 2 of a school orchestra book. They should be able to read music, identify and play common flats and sharps, identify and use extended hand positions comfortably, and be proficient on all four strings. A good grasp of rhythm and intonation is crucial! Cellists should have some introductory shifting experience.

Please do not sign up for Intermediate unless you solidly meet the requirements.

Requirements note for parents and teachers:

This program is for students in 10th grade and under, (typically entering 8th - 10th grade) who are able to read music, have some previous ensemble experience, can play **independently** on their instruments. A good grasp of rhythm and intonation is crucial!

ALSO:

Advanced Strings: should be comfortable shifting in 1st—4th positions. (Cellists 1st-5th position)

Advanced flute: students should have a 2-octave

range, & experience with sharps.

Please do not sign up for Advanced unless you solidly meet the requirements. Call or email with questions, we are happy to help.

Students new to NVYO programs may be asked to play a short, informal audition for placement purposes, after registration is received.

Dal Segno (pronounced "Dahl SAYN-yo) is a camp for musicians in 10th grade & younger, run by Northern Valley Youth Orchestras.
